about the gallery

The gallery occupies the ground floor of a wide terrace building, opening onto Enmore Rd. There are large full length windows allowing for plenty of light (and good visibility of works on display for passersby). The exhibition space is spread over two rooms. The rooms are set up for exhibiting both framed and unframed works. (See floor plan on last page.)

The front room has approximately 14.5 linear metres of wall space with a track hanging system installed. The walls are lined with sheet metal to allow for convenient magnet attachment of unframed works on paper.

The smaller second room offers a further 8 linear metres of wall space with track and magnet hanging. And additional 2.5 linear metres of track only hanging.

There is access to a kitchenette (with sink, bar fridge and microwave), toilet and the courtyard. If you are wanting to use the space for a workshop there is also access to the facilities in our studio/print workshop (by arrangement).

There is plenty of access to public transport—we are close to bus stops for several handy routes and Newtown Station is about ten minutes walk away. There is usually free parking available close by (if not immediately outside the gallery). For delivery and pick up of art works we can also offer on-site parking.

how the gallery operates

The standard hire period is for two weeks running from Tuesday to Monday. Limited single week hires may be available and we are more than happy to accommodate bookings for longer periods.

The gallery is usually open 12–6pm Thurs, Fri, Sat and 12–4pm Sun. However you can choose the opening hours that suit you best, and when you want to have an opening event. The only restriction is that the flat above the gallery is occupied, so late nights are not possible.

You are responsible for organising the sitting the gallery while it is open and for taking payments of sales.

what we offer

- Gallery hanging system for framed works (including wires and hooks)
- Magnets for displaying works on paper
- Step ladder, laser level and spirit level
- Two large plinths, one small plinth and a set of kauri pine plan drawers for exhibiting 3D works. (The plan drawers and moveable cupboards shown on the plan can also function as surfaces for displaying 3D works.)
- Advice and assistance (as required) for hanging the exhibition
- Use of glasses, platters and tables for events
- Signage and room sheets (as required)
- Promotion through our social media (one email to our subscribers, three posts to Instagram and Facebook)

what we charge

- From 1 January 2027 the fee to hire the gallery will be \$1,840 for a two week show.
- Additional weeks, that is for three or more week shows can be added for \$910 per week.
- A limited number of single week shows may be available for \$970 each.
- We ask for a non-refundable \$250 deposit to confirm a booking with the agreed balance due one week before the first day of the booking period.
